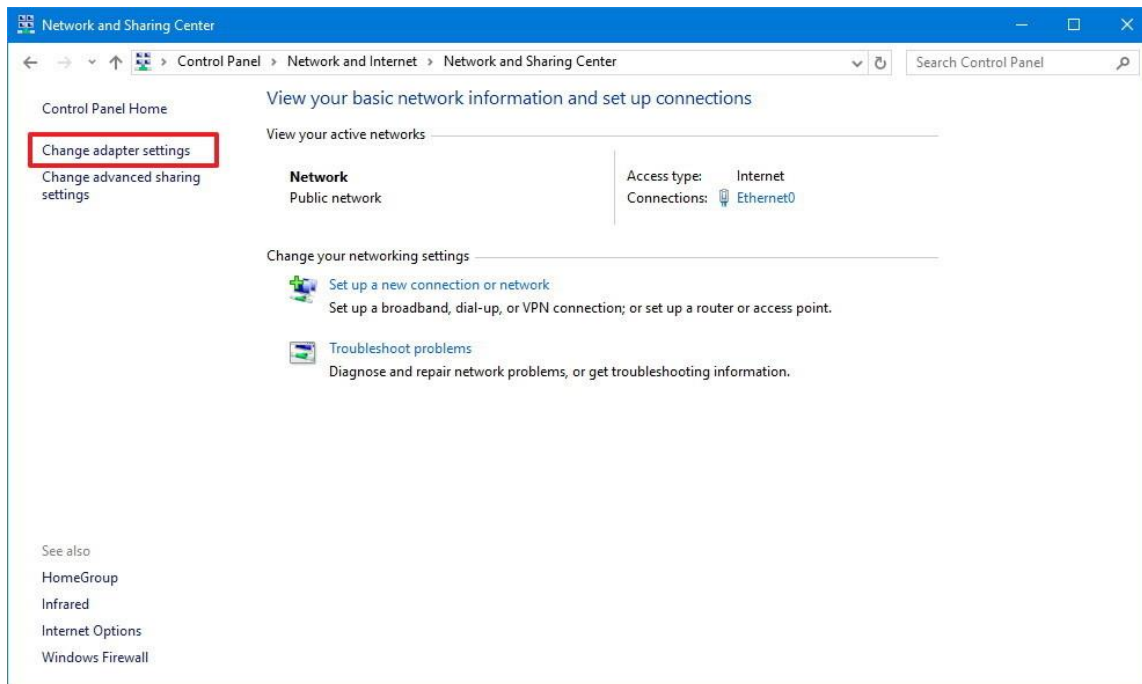


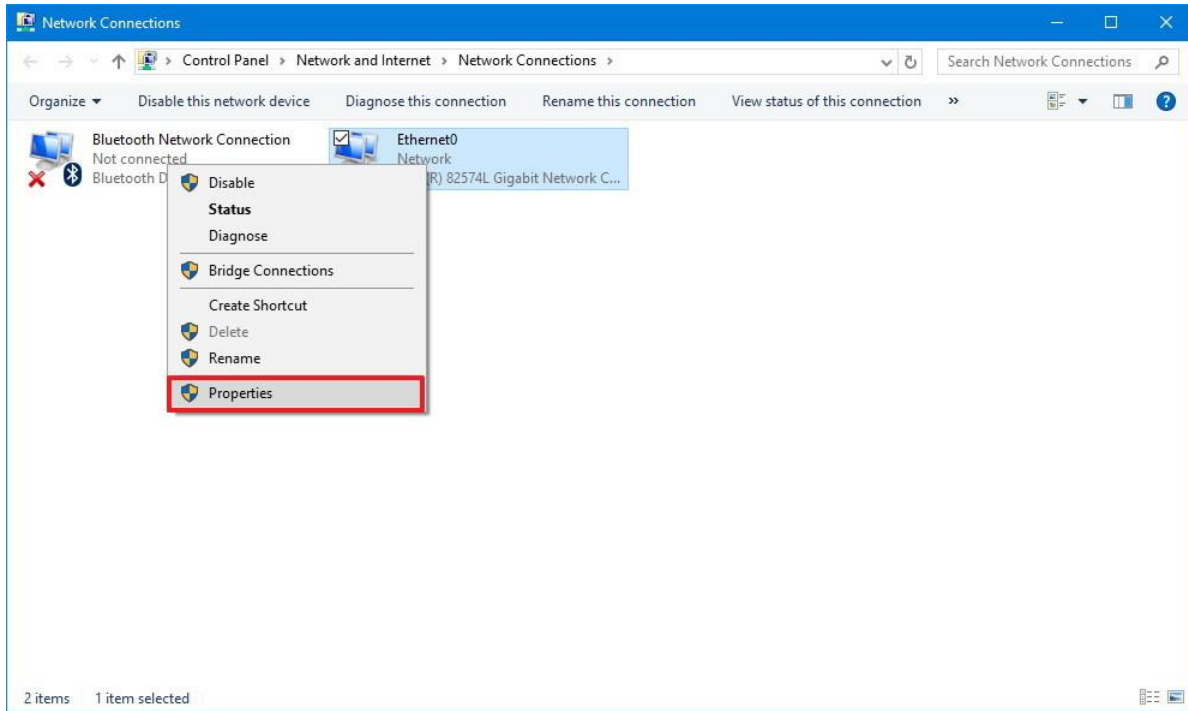
To change the DNS settings on your Windows 10 do the following:

1. Open Control Panel.
2. Click on Network and Internet.
3. Click on Network and Sharing Center.
4. On the left pane, click on Change adapter settings.



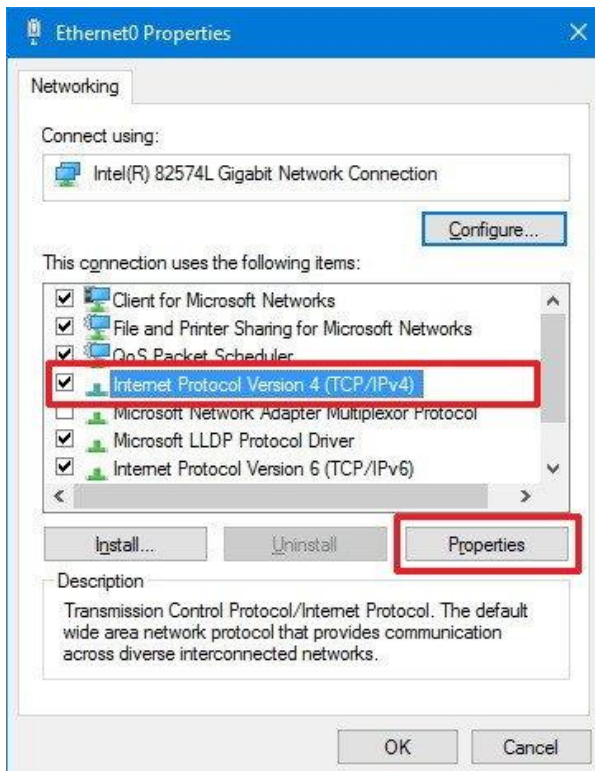
5. Right-click the network interface connected to the internet, and select Properties.

## SUNNY-NET Static DNS Setup Instructions for Windows 7

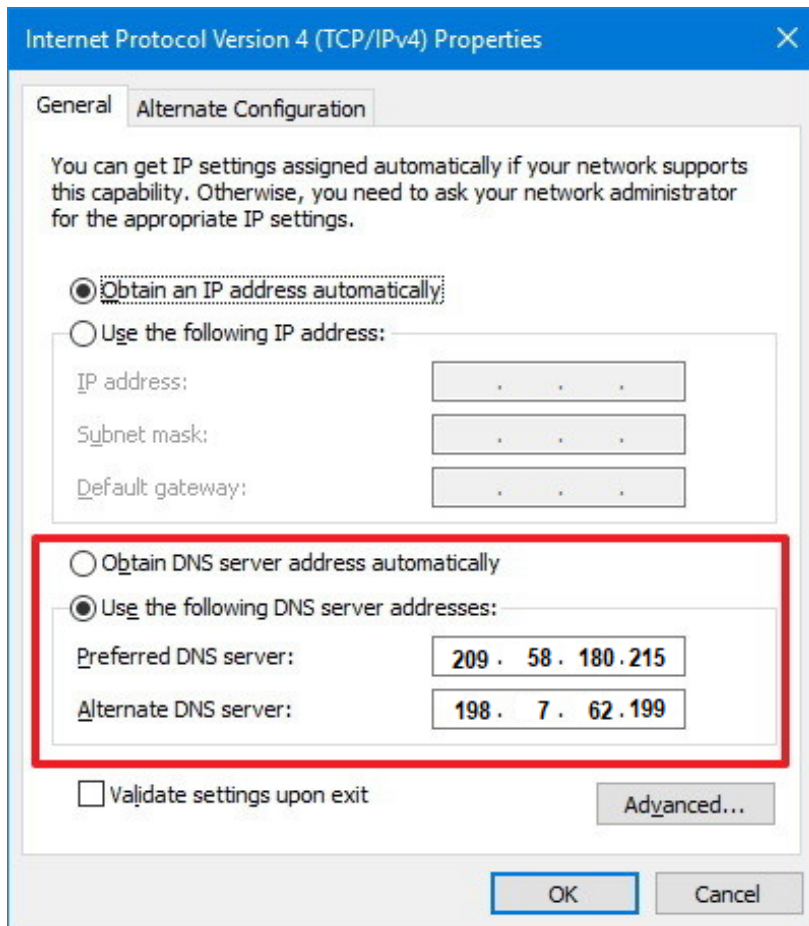


6. Select Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4) from the list.

7. Click the Properties button.



8. Click the Use the following DNS server addresses option.
9. Type in the following preferred and alternate DNS server addresses.
  - 209.58.180.215
  - 198.7.62.199
10. Click OK.



11. Click Close to apply the new DNS settings to the adapter.

Once you complete these steps, your computer will immediately start using the new DNS settings.
