

Windows 7 - Static DNS setup

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Aim of this article:


This article provides instructions on configuring Windows 7 to use statically assigned DNS server addresses.

Setup:

Begin by clicking Windows Logo > **Control Panel**.



Click **Network and Internet**.




Click on **Network & Sharing Center**.




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Click the name of the connection you wish to edit, to the right of **Connections**.




Click **Properties**. You will then be presented with the following window.



Select **Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)** and click **Properties**.

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Click the radio button next to **Use the following DNS server addresses:**. This will allow you to enter the DNS server addresses.

The DNS addresses are as follows:

Preferred DNS server: **209.58.180.215**

Alternate DNS server: **198.7.62.199**

Click **OK** on each of the windows and close the Control Panel. Your computer is now configured to use statically assigned DNS server addresses.
