


SUNNY-NET Static DNS Setup Instructions for D-Link

1. Visit the router's IP address (<http://192.168.0.1>) in a new browser window.

If you are attempting to configure a D-Link router, take note of your computer's Default Gateway IP address. The Default Gateway is the IP address of the D-Link router. By default, it should be 192.168.0.1. Most D-Link devices use the 192.168.0.X range. [[D-Link Support](#)]


2. Enter the router password.

Note: if you have not changed the original settings, the default username is **admin** and the password is blank (nothing).

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4. Enter the Sunny SmartDNS addresses in Primary DNS Server and Secondary DNS Server fields.

Please write down your current DNS settings before switching to SmartDNS, in case you want to return to your old settings for any reason, if you have any.
