

SUNNY-NET PPPoE Setup Instructions for D-Link

D-Link Wireless Router PPPoE Setup Instructions

First of all, connect to your D-Link wireless router either through Wi-Fi, or Ethernet. Next, open up a web browser and type in the following address: **192.168.0.1**

Username: admin

Password:

Select **MANUAL INTERNET CONNECTION SETUP**. Please continue with the next 6 steps.

1. Select « *PPPoE* ».
2. A little lower down, you will see « *User Name* ». Enter your Internet Username that SUNNY-NET provided.
3. Enter your password in the « *Password* ».
4. Confirm your password under « *Verify Password* ».
5. Select « *Always-On* ».
6. Finish by clicking « *Save Settings* » in the middle part of the page.
